

THE FLASHCAM CONTINUES TO EXCEED EXPECTATIONS

With the high success rate of the FlashCAM deterrence system, word has gotten out that FlashCAM is helping fight the battle against crimes such as graffiti, illegal dumping and metal theft. Our customers typically purchase a system in hopes of tackling a specific crime in mind, but many times the images captured by the FlashCAM are more than what they expected.

In 2010, St. Louis, MO was ranked as the most dangerous city in the US. In addition to the high volume of violent crimes, crimes such as illegal dumping have deteriorated the city. With this huge and expensive issue at hand, the St. Louis Police Department installed 129 FlashCAMs throughout the city, and prosecuted over 200 cases within the first two months of installation. Typical images captured are of people in pick-up trucks dumping loads of tires, yard wastes or construction scrap... until a series of images of three gunmen crossing the path of an illegal dumping site were downloaded from the FlashCAM. With the high resolution images of these gunmen, they were identified as the suspects in a nearby shooting and later prosecuted.

Similarly, Youngstown, OH has been burdened by illegal dumpers and installed FlashCAMs at trouble locations. Within two weeks of installation, they identified six illegal dumpers, but have found that the systems are helping the city address the issue of metal theft as well. Over 200 manhole covers have been stolen in the past few months and the city has spent more than \$20,000 to replace them. A man was recently captured on a FlashCAM stealing a cover, and is now being

charged with theft.

Detering drug deals at vandalism sites, prostitution at graffiti locations...the FlashCAM does not discriminate the crime and continues to deter any unwanted nuisance crime, regardless of the primary purpose of installation. Tackling crime is the objective of the FlashCAM and will continue to help create safer and cleaner cities across the nation.
